Recycling

- Property owners have the responsibility to ensure that manufacturers capacity ratings are enforced when any Golf Carts, NLV's or boats are operated on LLPOA property
- All NLV's (Golf Cart, Side by Side, Quad, etc.) must be registered yearly and **display a LLPOA Tag on the rear of the vehicle in plain sight**, to operate on LLPOA property

Lake wide speed limit is 15 mph

- All NLV's must have a visible day glow flag on their vehicle at a minimum height of 5 foot
- All Electric Motorboats must be registered yearly and display a LLPOA Tag placed on the front left side of the watercraft, to operate on LLPOA property

We all love the freedom of the lake so please be respectful of others when operating any vehicles or NLV's. It is a privilege to be able to use Leisure Lake roads and facilities, so we ask that everyone is mindful of others, children, adults, and animals.


- Acceptable items include household trash only
- An average of 3 35-gallon bags per week are allowed
- No unbagged recyclables (carboard boxes or large plastic items)
- Recyclables are no longer accepting in the LLPOA dumpsters.
 They must be taken to the Otter Creek recycling dumpsters of 183rrd Avenue
- Visit the website for information on where to take unacceptable items
